The park is situated in the middle of Manhattan. The park is 4 kilometres long and covers 340 hectares. Central

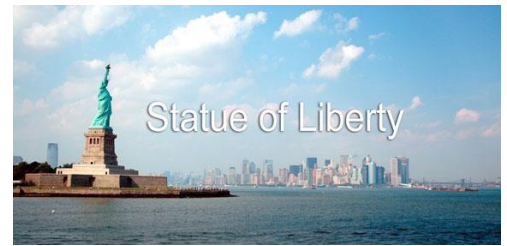

The Empire State Building is the most famous skyscraper in NY. It has 6,500 windows and 73 elevators.

Times Square is the liveliest intersection in Manhattan, at the junction of Broadway and Seventh Avenue. It is a great symbol of New York, the best place to go at night.
