What is a root canal treatment?



What are the symptoms of the root canal?

We have mentioned some symptoms of root canal infection below that requires an immediate visit to **Houston Dentist** such as:

- Stubborn pain.
- Sensitivity to heat and cold temperatures
- Tooth discoloration of tooth
- Swollen gum line
- Pain while chewing
- Have a chipped, cracked, or broken tooth
- Unstable Tooth

What is the reason behind pulp damage?

The major reason for pulp getting infected is due to deep decay and multiple dental procedures on a tooth, it can be also due to large dental fillings. A person can face irritated, inflamed, and infected tooth pulp if he/she is suffering from a chipped or cracked tooth.

How long does a root canal take?

A root canal process can take time according to the amount of damage and infection in the tooth. We have found from studies that root canal procedure takes one to three appointments on an average including each appointment duration of 30

minutes to 60 minutes. If you are having multiple root canals then it may take longer than expected.

Who is not the right candidate for root canal treatment?

If you are suffering from any of the health conditions mentioned below, then you're not eligible for root canal treatment:

- If a person is suffering from a high blood pressure condition in daily life
- If a person is suffering from diabetes
- If an individual is suffering from autoimmune disease
- If a person is suffering from allergies and infection
- If a person is suffering from osteoporosis
