Dental bonding is a cosmetic surgery that improves your smile by using tooth-colored composite resin. This treatment can fix chipped, fill in gaps, or alter a tooth's shape and color. Dental bonding is reversible, unlike other cosmetic dental procedures like porcelain veneers.

What materials are used in dental bonding?

In composite dental bonding, fillings that match the tooth's natural color are applied to one or more teeth

During the **dental bonding miami** treatment, the **dentist in miami** uses specialized glue, and tooth-colored composite resin material is used. They use a powerful curing light to attach the materials to your teeth. After that, they polish the teeth. Dental bonding requires one appointment to complete.

What takes place with gluing teeth?

Your dentist will perform the following throughout the dental bonding process

- Choose a color. The dentist chooses a composite resin material that closely resembles the color of your natural teeth using a shade guide.
- **Get your teeth ready**. Afterward, they chap your tooth's surface and apply a liquid conditioner over the affected area. These actions aid in the bonding substance's adhesion to your tooth.
- Use the composite resin substance. Then, they apply the putty-like resin material to shape it and smooth it into the demanded structure.
- Cure the substance. In the next step, they bond the composite resin to the surface of your tooth and harden it using a specialized curing light.
- Shine up that tooth. Next, your dentist will make any required last-minute modifications and polish your tooth to a natural gloss.
- Each tooth takes between 30 and 60 minutes to finish the operation.



Dental bonding is used to close spaces between teeth and repair indentations caused by excessive wear, such as teeth grinding. Also, they utilize temporary crowns or fillings in this treatment. They rarely use local anesthesia because the entire process is painless.

The average dental bonding cost may be between \$100 and \$400 for each tooth.
