# Why Do Dental Experts Need To Remove Wisdom Teeth?

Wisdom teeth are the third set of teeth in your mouth, and they typically appear between ages 17 and 25 and are detected on X-rays. According to a <u>Miami orthodontist</u>, the majority of people have them removed for one of the following reasons:

- They are impacted. Wisdom teeth may not come in generally because they are so far back in your mouth. They can get stuck or trapped in your jawbone or gums, causing pain.
- They approach from the wrong side, which may pressure your other teeth.
- Your mouth is too small, and there is no room for an extra set of molars in your jaw.
- You have tooth decay or gum disease. Your toothbrush or dental thread, or floss may not be able to reach your wisdom teeth.



# When is wisdom teeth removal necessary?

When wisdom teeth cause problems or X-rays show they may be in the future, you must extract them. According to **wisdom teeth removal Miami**, other compelling reasons to remove them include:

- Damage to other teeth: Having an extra set of teeth can cause your other adult teeth to move from their place, causing dental pain and bite issues.
- Cysts can develop around the newly formed teeth, causing jaw damage. They could perhaps hollow out your jaw and harm nerves if not treated.
- Sinus Problems: Wisdom tooth problems can cause sinus pain, stress, and congestion.
- Inflamed gums: Tissue around the impacted or infected area may swell and become difficult to clean.

- Alignment: Impacted wisdom teeth can cause teeth crowding of other teeth and even necessitate treatment to straighten other teeth.

# What happens during the wisdom tooth removal procedure?

Before **adult orthodontics Miami** specialists extract your wisdom teeth, they will numb the teeth and surrounding tissue with a local anesthetic – the same type used to numb a tooth before filling it with a cavity. In addition to a local anesthetic to relieve pain, you and your dentist or oral surgeon may decide that a sedative is necessary to alleviate any anxiety.



They could use nitrous oxide( also known as laughing gas), an oral or intravenous sedative. You can drive yourself home if they give you nitrous oxide. According to <u>wisdom teeth removal cost Miami</u>, If you choose other medications, you will need someone to drop you to and from the appointment.

## What happens after the wisdom tooth extraction procedure?

Schedule time off from work, camp, or school for your surgery. You should relax for the rest of the day. Some people can drive themself to and from surgery. However, if you are under general anesthesia or taking pain relievers, your parents must drive you. Most people experience slight to no pain at all as a result of the procedure.

It may take a few days to feel normal again, but you can return to school, camp, or work the following day. Your dental specialist will give you a list of instructions to follow as you leave the office. These suggestions will help you heal faster, reduce pain and swelling, and fight infection.
