#### **Tank to Tank installation**

Generally, it takes 2-3 hours to replace a gas or electric water tank with a similar model. It involves draining, disconnecting, and removing your old water heater,

occupying almost 45 to 60 minutes. Further, it takes about 30 minutes to install a new unit and another 45 to 60 minutes to put the new connection points and ensure that all functions are up to code.

#### **Tank to Tankless installation**

This installation process is a bit time-consuming. The process involves installing new power and water lines and air vents. Further, the tankless unit is mounted and connected.

#### **Tankless to Tankless Installation**

This type of installation requires one to three hours, depending upon how they are vented.

## **Reduced Hot Water Capacity**

Are you running out of hot water? Reduced water capacity indicates wear and tear, meaning replacing is the solution.

## **A Slow Drip Leak**

Most leaks start minor, but if you leave them untreated, you are putting your home in danger. Call a professional for replacement.

# **Rising Energy Bills**

#### **Sediment Accumulation**

Sediment build-up in your tank might cause muddy or sandy water. You need an expert to check it.

## **Aging**

Most water heaters last for 10-15 years. If yours is older, it may need a replacement.
