## TEN LITTLE ELEPHANTS

## Teacher's Notes

## Target Language

Numbers 1-10

## Instructions

1 If there are more than ten students in your class, divide them into groups of ten or less. Allocate a number between 1 and 10 to each student. All the students in one group should have different numbers (one student should always be 1). Ask all the students to stand up.
2 As the students sing, any student whose number is mentioned sits down.
3 For the second half of the song, number the students 10, 20, 30, etc.

## Variation

Instead of standing up and sitting down, they could hold up ten fingers, reveal or cover up pictures of elephants, dance in a circle and all fall down except one student (or ten students) at the end.

## Follow up

1 The students can count in multiples of two, three, four, etc. backwards or forwards.
2 Other animals can be used instead of elephants. The students can mime the animal and/or make the sound of the animal after each verse, or at the end of the song.
