
CEDAR SUET FEEDER



NOTES

- 1. Materials: 3/4" Cedar Tongue and Grove, 5 1/2" Cedar Clad Board, 1/4" Fencing, 2 ea 1/2" Eye Screws, 1 1/4" Dry Wall Screws, 1/4" Nylon Rope (20"). All Materials available at a good Home Improvement Store.
- 2. Use Waterproof glue for assembly.
- 3. Bottom and Roof Supports were made by gluing the Tongue and Groove together to get the proper width.
- 4. Roof "Shingles' were cut from 5 1/2" Cedar Clad Board starting at the 1/2" thick bottom end for the 3" Shingle then measure up for the 1 1/2" one.
- 5. Base was glued and screwed to Bottom Support
- 6. Fence Screen overlaps Base Support 1" and is stapled in place
- 7. Roof shingles: Bottom were glued and screwed to Roof Support, Top were just glued
- 8. You can cut evenly spaced groves on the face of the Bottom Support to give some "purchase" for the Woodpecker's Tails
- 9. Roof is screwed onto Fence Screen from both sides
- 10. This was designed to fit the standard 11oz 4 1/4"x 4 1/4"x 1 1/2' Suet Cake

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
