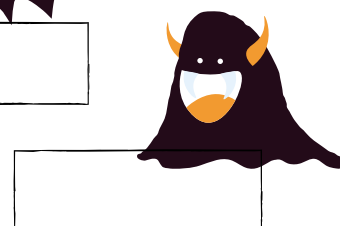
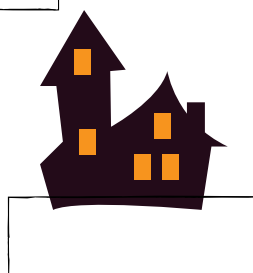
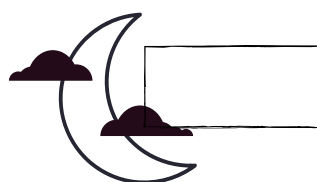
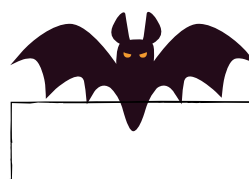
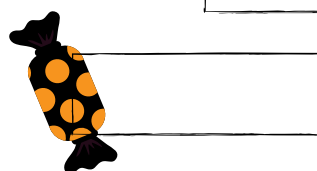
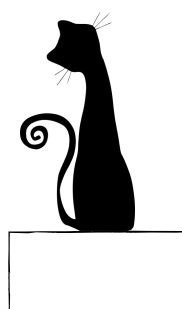
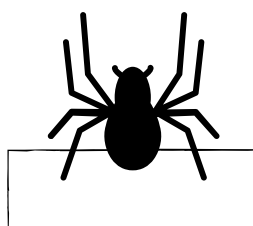
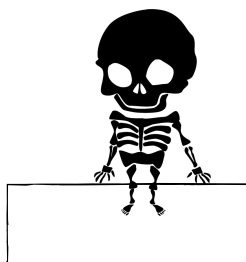
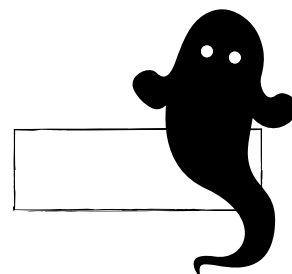
Halloween is celebrated on October 31st. It has its origin in the festival of Samhain among the Celts of ancient Britain and Ireland. It is now an international festival.

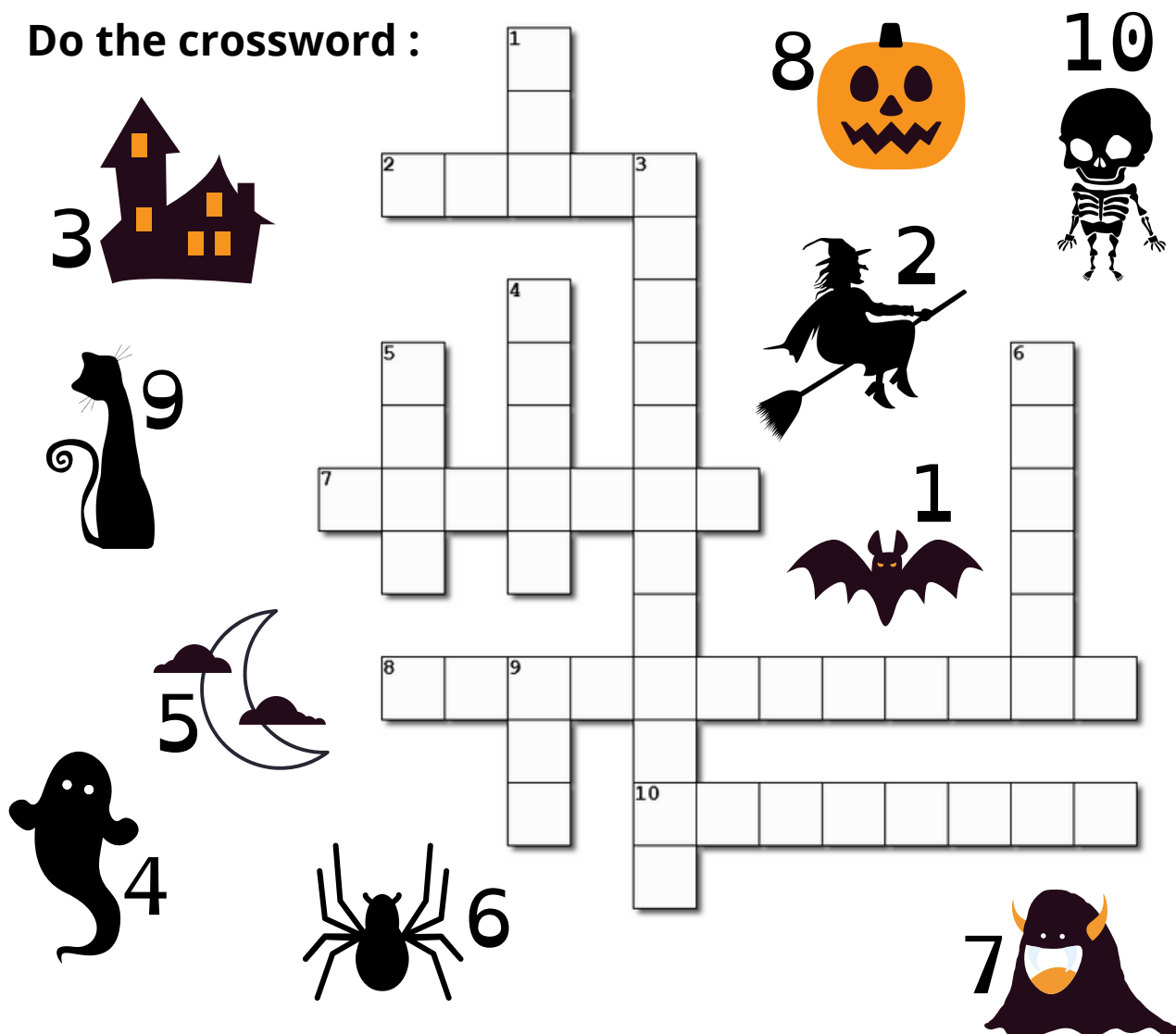
