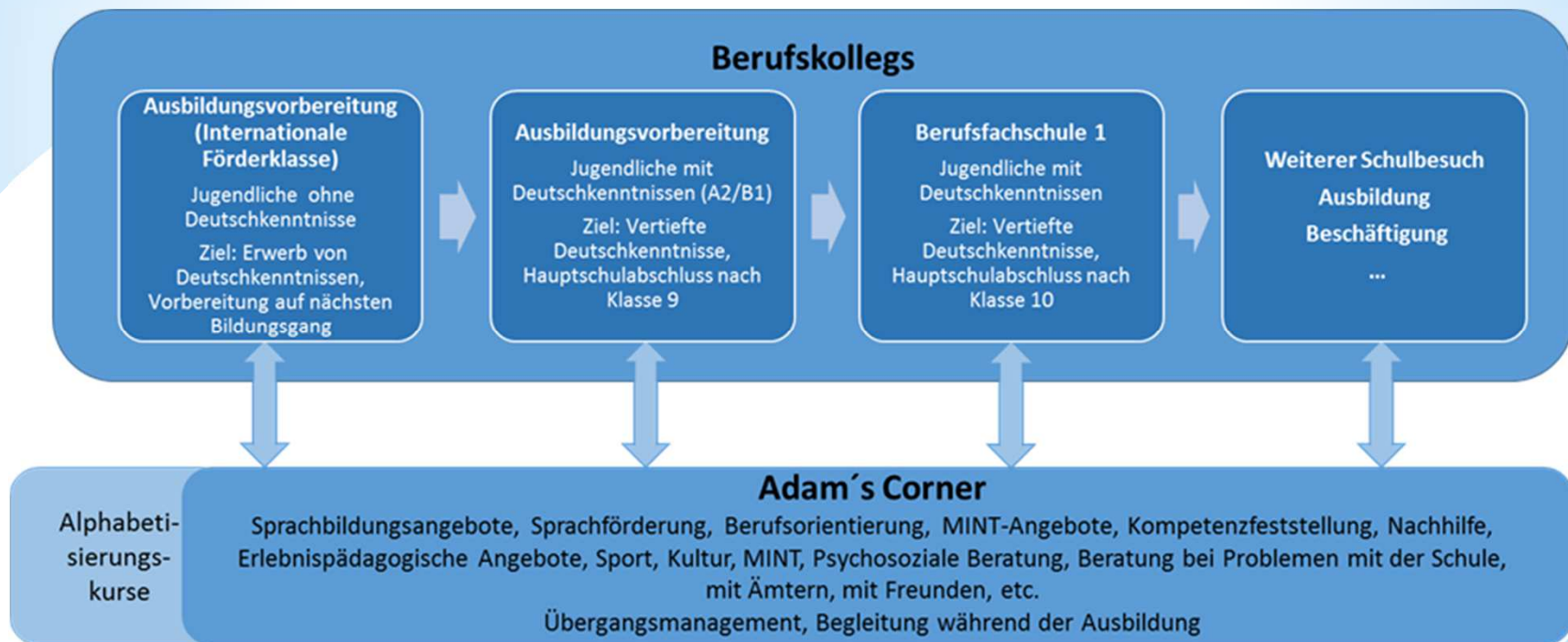

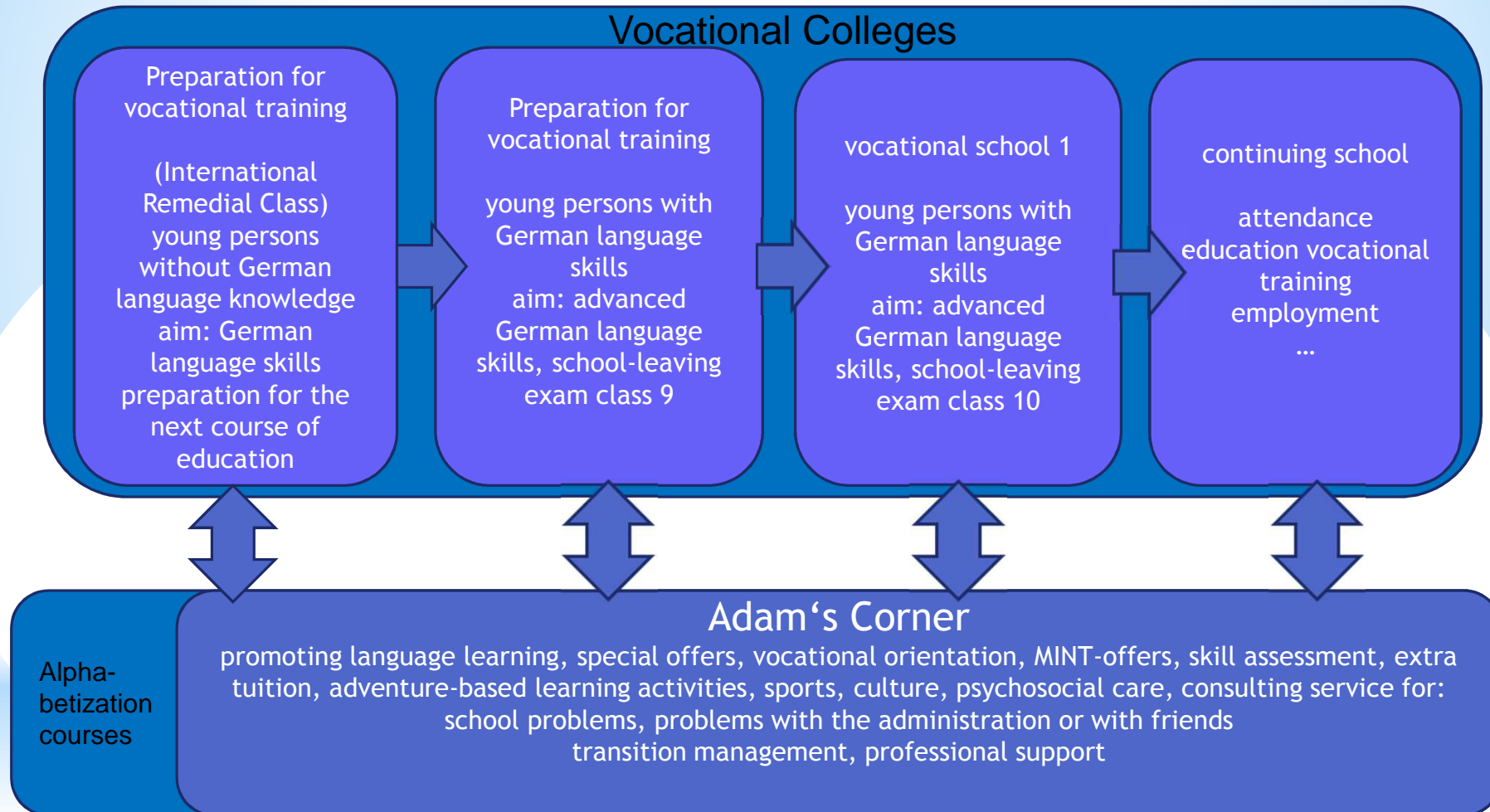
- The Ministry of Education and Further Education of North-Rhine Westphalia and the Walter-Blüchert Foundation developed a new concept for young refugees
- The Walter-Blüchert Foundation got in touch with districts and municipalities and made an agreement with e.g. the Stadt Dortmund (town in the Ruhr area, approx. 600.000 inhabitants)
- The Minister of Education, Sylvia Löhrmann, signed the first agreement in February 2015
- The Arrived at-Program started in August 2015
- Target group: new arrived refugees between the age of 16 - 25
- Several municipalities have followed ...

- * Partners: MSW - Walter-Blüchert Foundation -municipality or districts
- * Core concern: support for young refugees and immigrants to stabilise their life situation and to get a school-leaving qualification - prerequisite for a vocational training or an academic qualification
- * Based on two pillars: individual support for a quick qualification and individual treatment at a safe place after lessons
- * financed by the Walter-Blüchert Foundation, the municipality and the Ministry of Education (responsible teacher)
