
Irish education system



TRANSITION YEAR (TY)

Senior cycle is made up of **Transition Year** (often optional) and two full years that end with the Leaving Certificate¹.

In TY there are some obligatory subjects and modules (different lengths) and others that the students choose from to complete their timetable. Each school makes its own curriculum². Students are not evaluated with tests, but complete projects to validate their year.
