

1	COLCANNON	Irish food made of boiled pigs' feet, traditionally eaten by hands	
2	IRISH STEW	It consists of battered fish, cod or haddock, and deep-fried chips	
3	FISH AND CHIPS	A yeasted bread with added sultanas or raisins	
4	BARMBRACK	Dish made from lamb or mutton as well as potatoes, onions and parsley. It may sometimes include carrots.	
5	CRUBEENS	Traditional Irish dish consisting of mashed potatoes with kale or cabbage	
6	DUBLIN LAWYER	A meat pie with a crust of mashed potato	
7	COTTAGE PIE	Fresh lobster baked with cream and Irish whiskey
