	<b>PROS (ADVANTAGES)</b>	<b>CONS (DISADVANTAGES/DRAWBACKS/ DOWNSIDES/INCONVENIENCES)</b>
<b>Document A</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-You discover the reality of the working world</li> <li>-It helps the students to decide what they want for their future</li> <li>-You meet new people (friends?)</li> <li>-You become more autonomous and responsible</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-It's not interesting for students who don't like school and who are in a hurry to leave it</li> <li>-As you have no homework or tests,you lose the habit of working regularly</li> <li>-You forget many things (knowledge and skills) from prior schools years</li> </ul>
<b>Document B</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-You have more freedom</li> <li>-As you have no homework and no tests, the relationship between teachers and students is better</li> <li>-You learn essential things (social skills and practical skills)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- it's a big change in the school routine</li> <li>-it's a waste of time</li> <li>- there's too much freedom, so you take bad habits</li> <li>- you spend too much time socializing, making friends. It's useless</li> <li>- Depending on the schools, the programme and work experience can be more or less interesting and worthwhile</li> </ul>
<b>Document C</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- you expand your personal growth</li> <li>- you learn new skills</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- schools are not supposed to provide children with work experience</li> <li>- a TY is expensive : it costs a lot of money and school is supposed to be free.</li> </ul>
