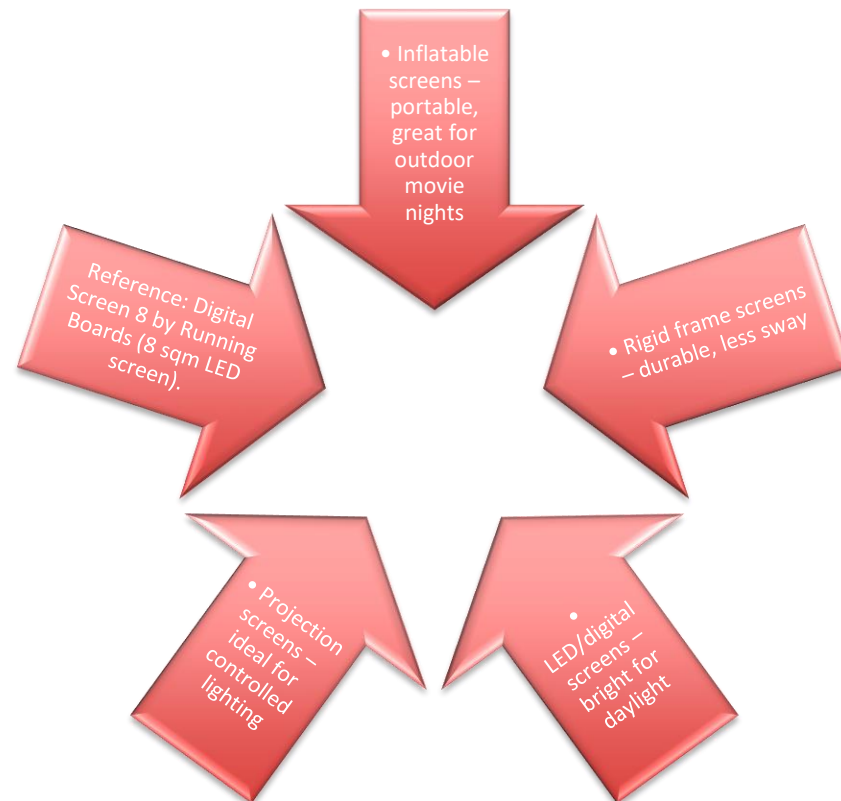

Tip: The screen width should be about  $\frac{1}{6}$  to  $\frac{1}{8}$  of the farthest viewer's distance.

# Screen Size & Aspect Ratio



- Bigger audiences need larger screens.



- Common aspect ratios: 16:9 (modern) and 4:3 (classic).



- Ensure the screen matches your video format.

# Brightness, Daylight & Lighting Conditions



- Daylight and sunlight can wash out images.

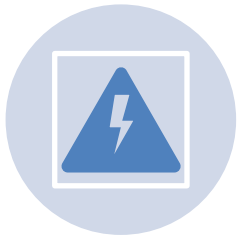


- Choose LED or high-lumen projectors for bright visibility.

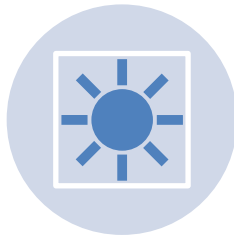


- Use shading or tents if needed.

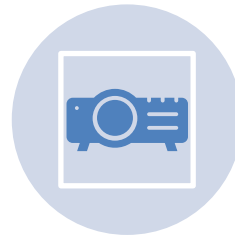
# Setup, Logistics & Site Requirements



- POWER SUPPLY AND GROUND STABILITY



- WIND TOLERANCE AND WEATHER CONDITIONS



- TRANSPORT AND SETUP TIME (~30 MINS FOR SOME LED SCREENS).



TIP: DO A SITE CHECK OR REQUEST PHOTOS FROM YOUR PROVIDER.

## Cost & Budget Considerations

- Cost depends on screen type, size, duration, and extras.

- Get multiple quotes for movie screen hire Queensland.

- Ask about bundled services and hidden fees.



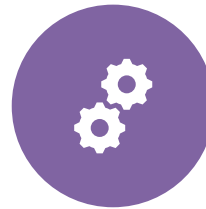
