

Why Billboard Trucks Matter for Aussie Businesses

- Mobile advertising is growing: digital mobile billboards give flexibility in message display.
- Large screens (e.g., 4.8m × 2.4m, plus rear screens) provide high visibility.
- GPS tracking, remote access, real-time updates help monitor campaigns.
- A billboard truck for sale can be a useful investment for mobile promotions.



Things to Consider When Buying New vs Used

New: Higher cost, warranty, latest tech, better resale value.

Used: Lower cost, possible maintenance issues, older tech, lower resale value.

Pros & Cons – New Billboard Trucks

Pros: Latest screens, remote updates, reliable, strong brand image.

Cons: High cost, depreciation, possible long lead times. Pros & Cons – Used Billboard Trucks Pros: Lower cost, faster acquisition, possible good condition finds.

Cons: Repairs needed, outdated screens, no warranty, lower resale value.

Cost Comparison & Total Cost of Ownership

Upfront Price: New trucks cost much more.

Operating Costs: Fuel, driver, insurance, maintenance.

Depreciation: New loses value faster but retains tech advantage.

ROI depends on usage frequency and ad revenue.

Key Features to Check (Both New & Used)



Screen size, brightness, resolution.



Remote access & artwork management.



GPS tracking and reporting capabilities.



Chassis, engine, electrical system condition.



Warranty / maintenance history.



Compliance with local regulations.

Which Option Works Best for Different Scenarios

Startups: Used may be better for lower budget.

Agencies: New trucks offer long-term ROI.

Event-based businesses: Used might suffice.

Brand-focused businesses: New trucks enhance image.
