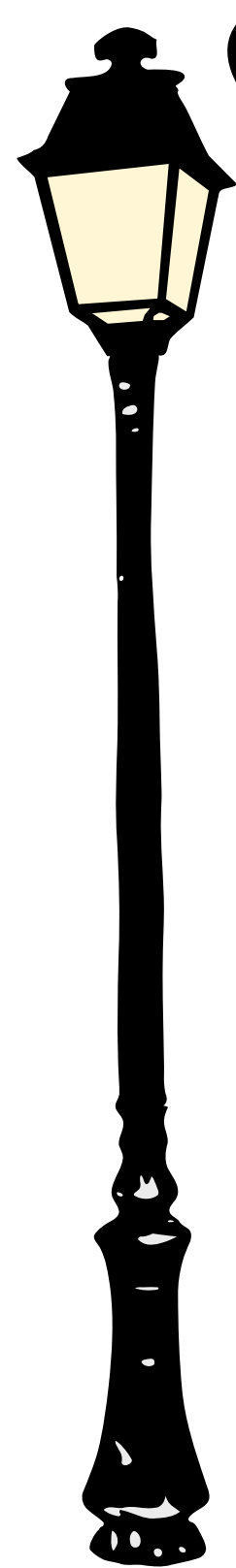




Introduction

The Great Britain Map



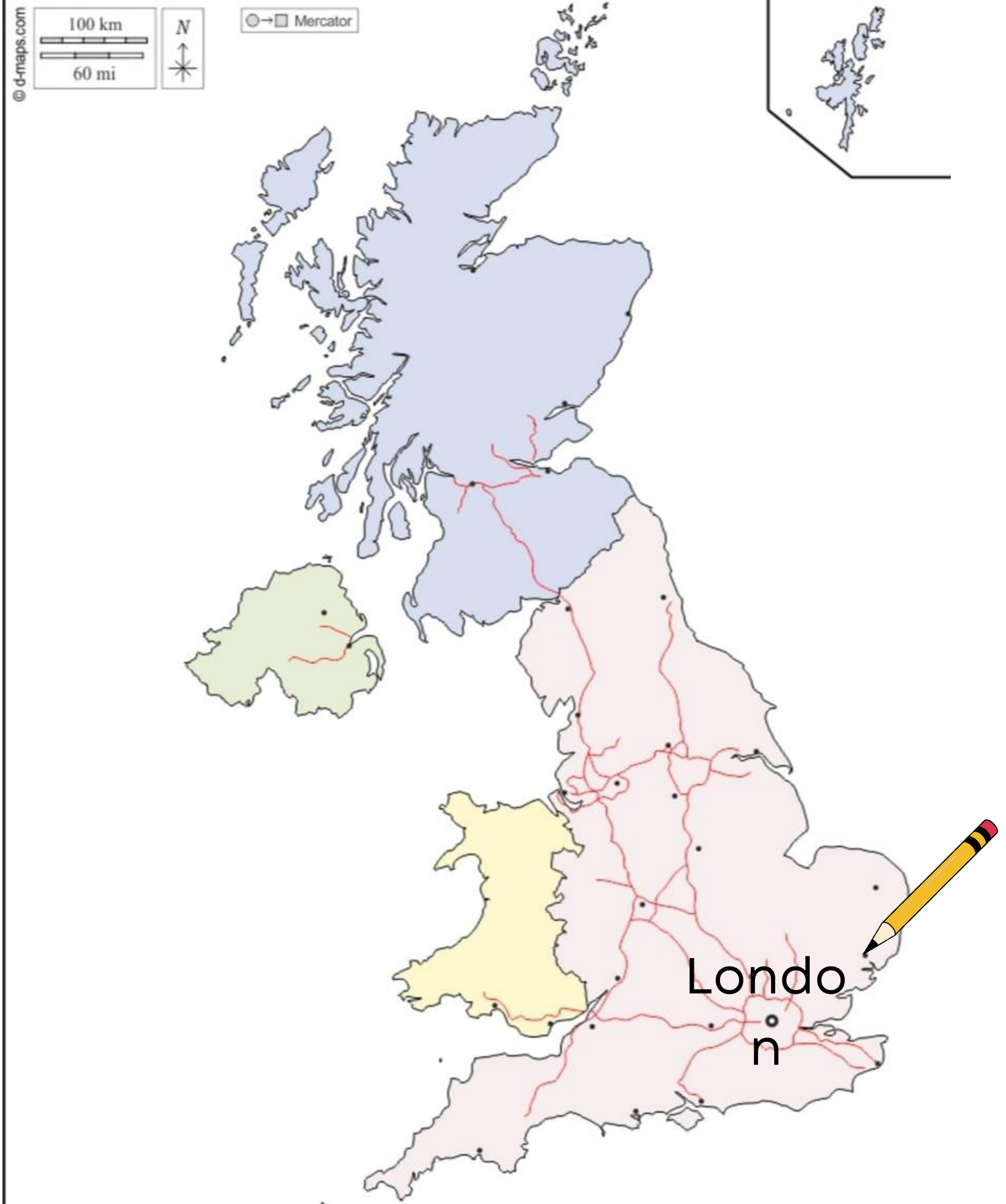
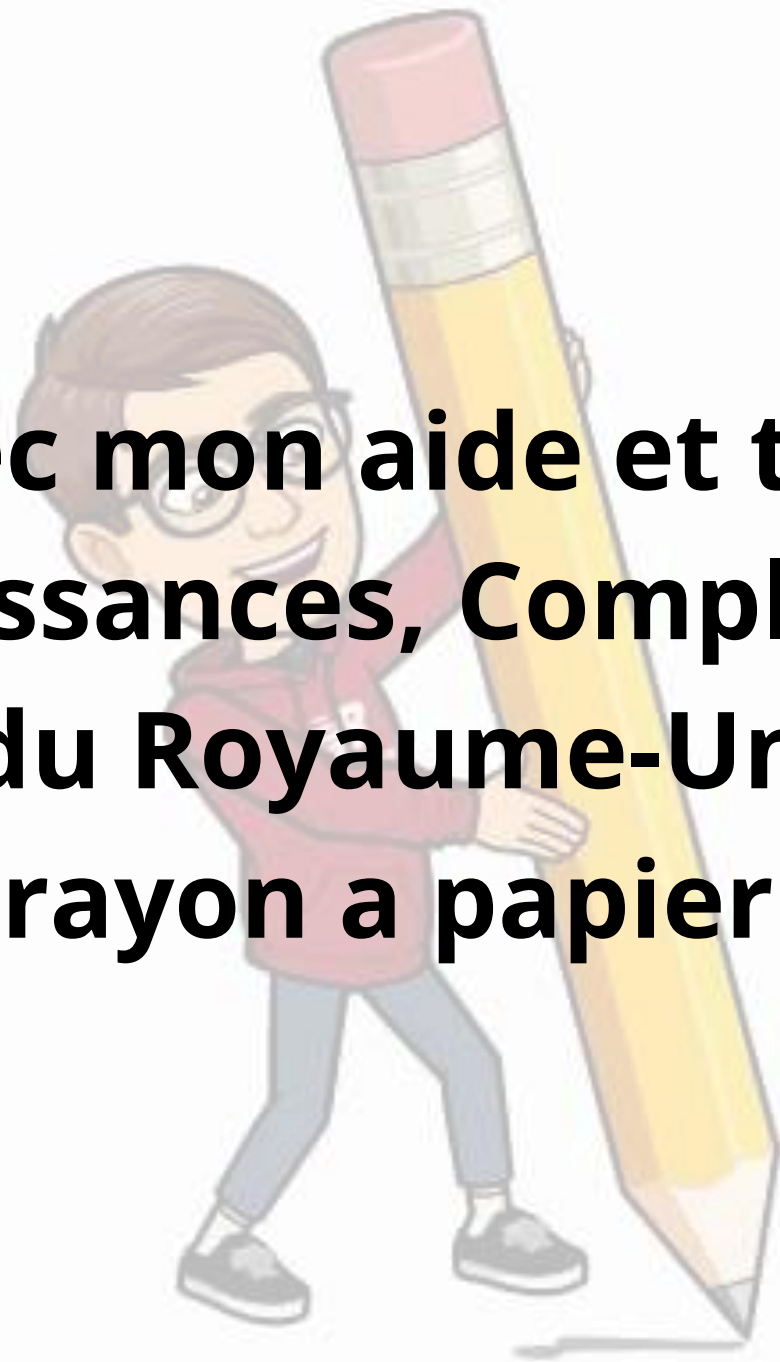

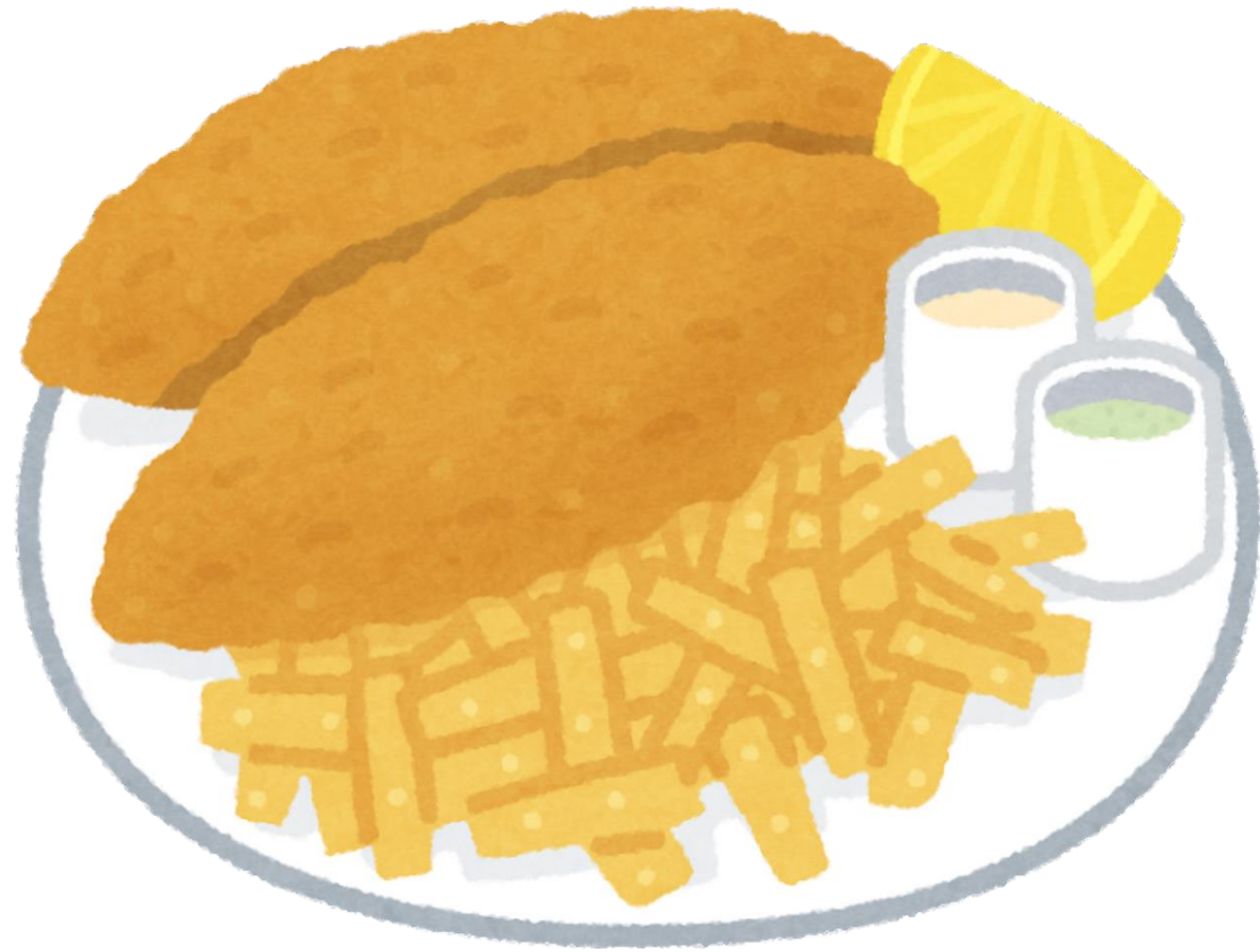


History

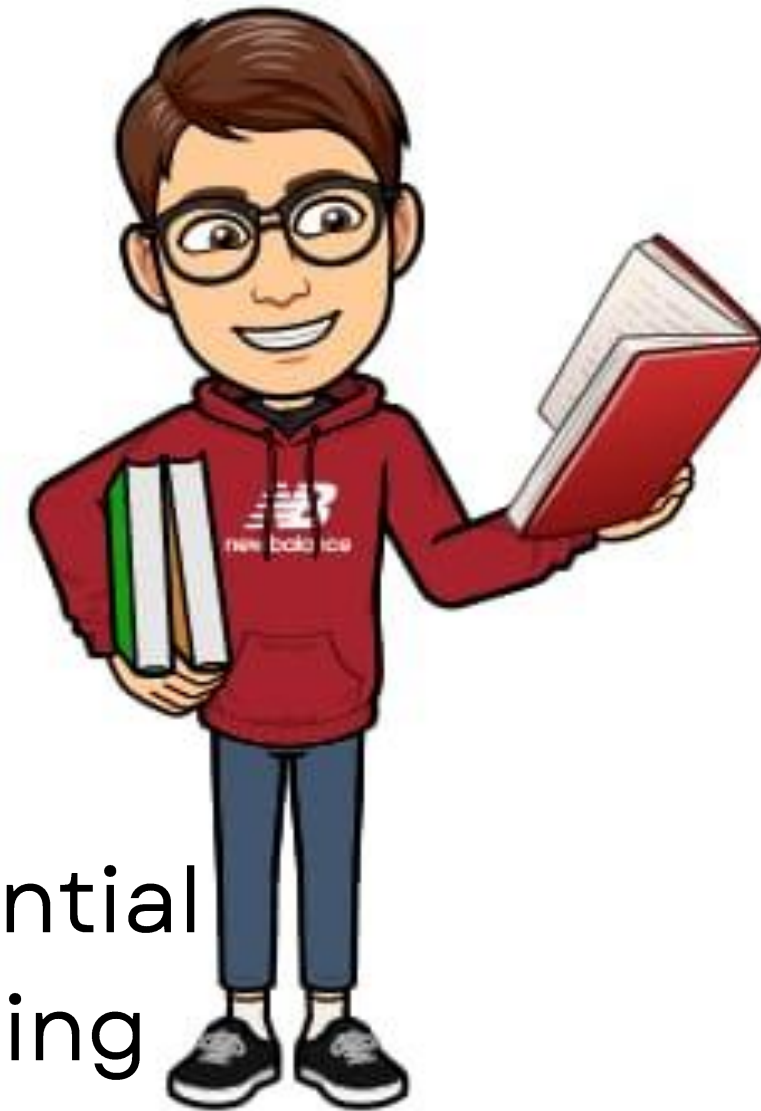

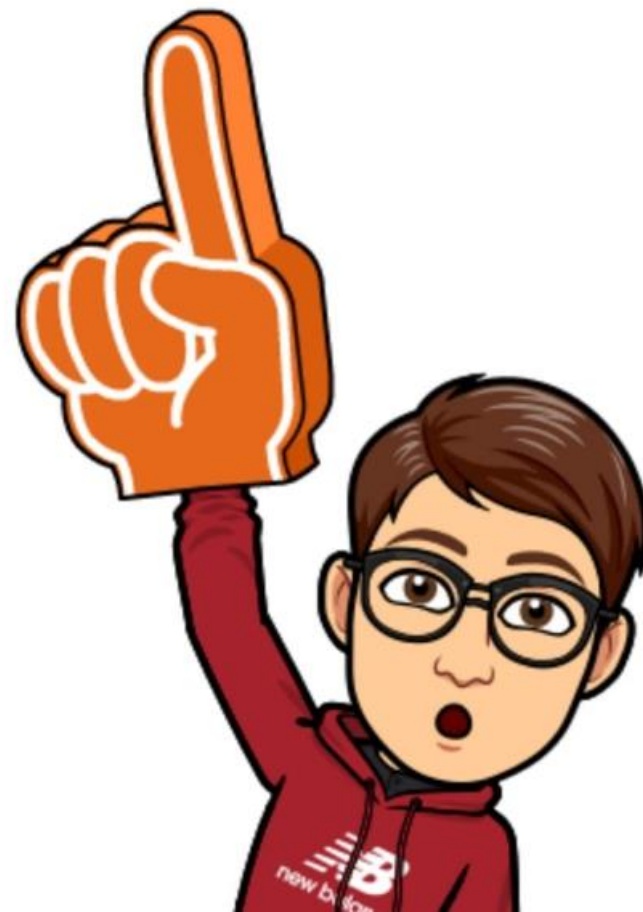

A Monument's of London!

1. The Big Ben



Big Ben is the most famous monument in London. After Buckingham Palace, it is visited by approximately 20 millions tourists per year and ranks among the 7 Wonders of the World.



2. The Buckingham Palace



Buckingham Palace is the official residence of the British sovereigns.

Located in the City of Westminster in London, the palace is both the venue for several events related to the royal family.

3. The Tower of London



The Tower of London is a castle located in London, along the Thames River. It was built by William the Conqueror around 1077 and was considerably expanded over the centuries. It is often simply called "the Tower" in England and has served as a fortress, palace, prison, treasury, arsenal, and zoo. The tower is located in the London borough of Tower Hamlets to the east of the City of London in an area called Tower Hill.



4. The Tower Bridge

The Tower Bridge (in French: "pont de la Tour") is a British drawbridge located in London, allowing the passage of the Thames for motorized vehicles.

It belongs to the class of suspension bridges and is made of granite for its facade, steel for its structure, and concrete for its foundations. It is located between the boroughs of Southwark and Tower Hamlets, near the Tower of London from which it derives its name.

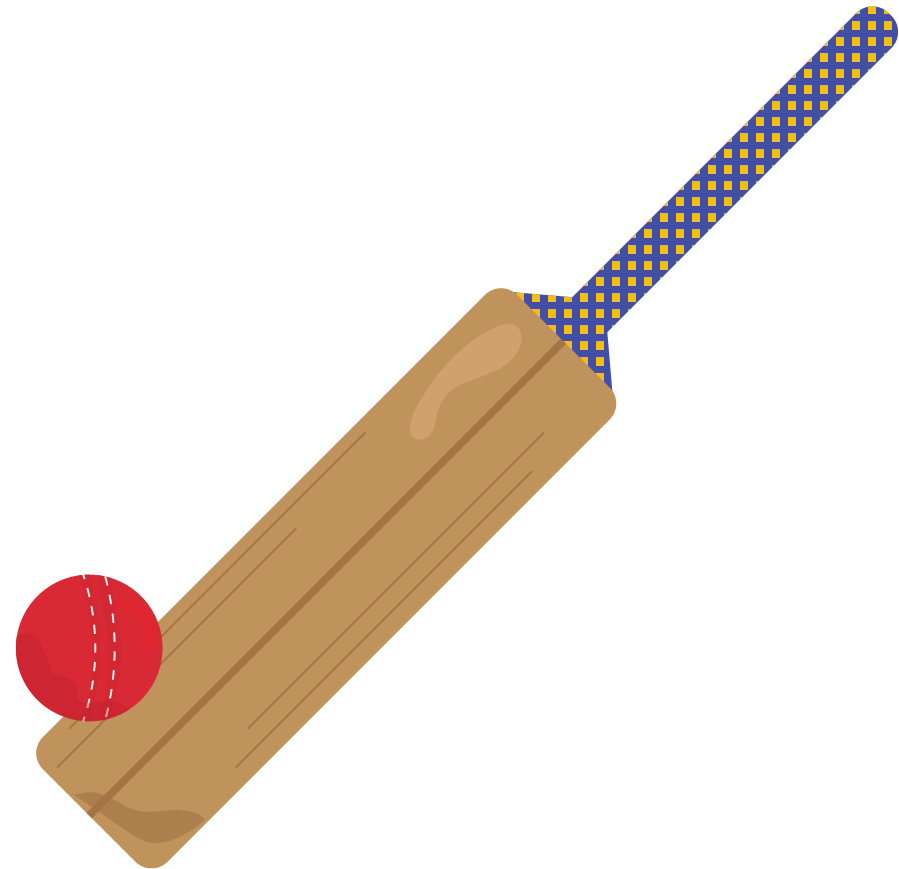

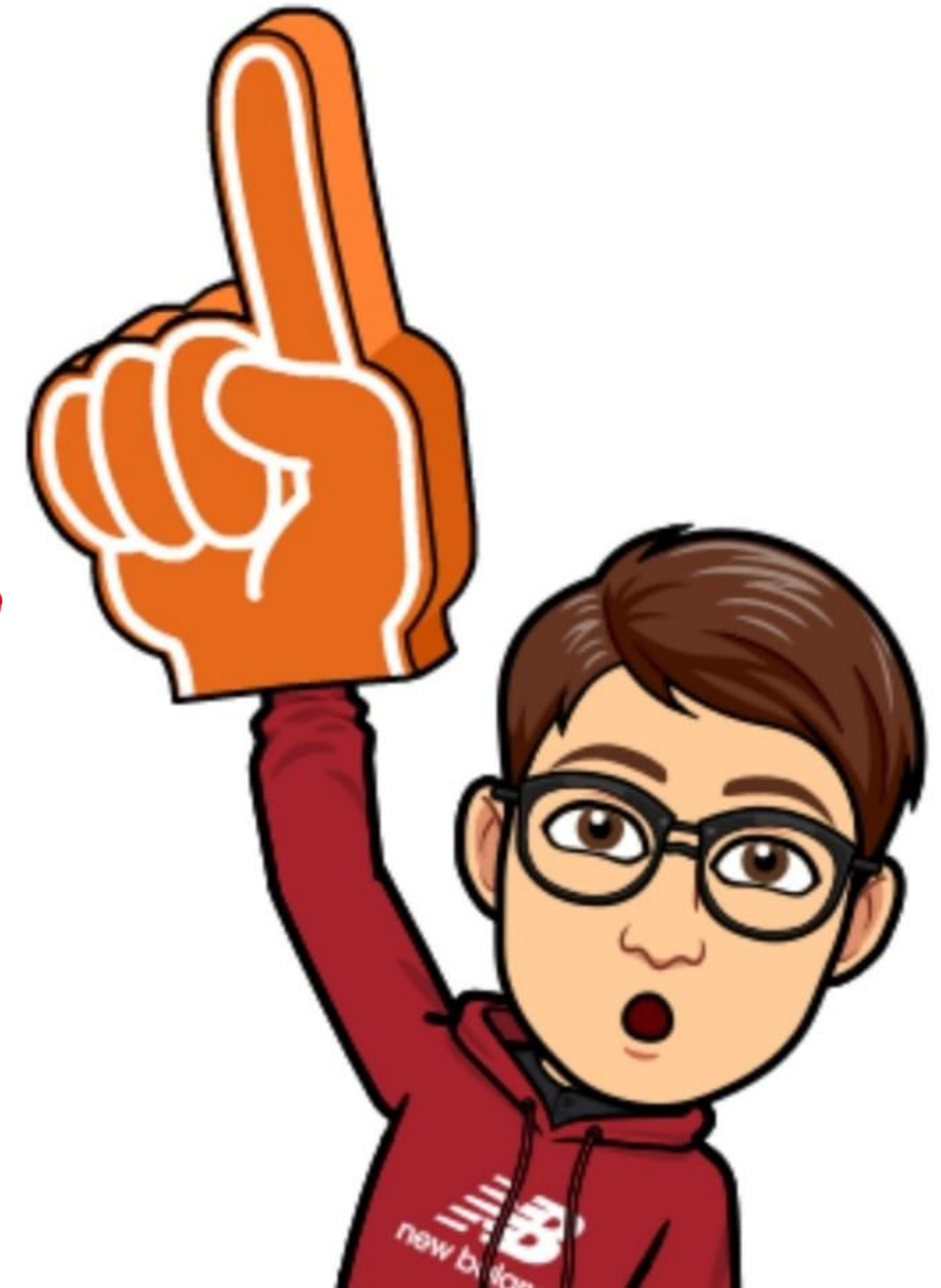
