







This reading activity is a perfect way to revise strategies (select information for the 5Ws and 1H). It will be ideal to work on the letter layout.

As a first task, ask your students to answer this invitation.


Start with the admission letter







What a prefect does at Hogwarts

Prefects have other responsibilities as student leaders. They show the first years the way to their dormitories on their first day of school at Hogwarts School of Witchcraft and Wizardry, and supervise the decorating of the castle for Christmas (and other events as well). They also watch the younger students when bad weather keeps them indoors over break times.

Prefects are given a badge; the colours are the colours of the prefect's House. They have to wear the badge on their school uniform. The badge would have the letter "P" on it. If the refect is on his or her house Quidditch team, e or she would not be required to wear the prefect badge on their Quidditch robes.






