

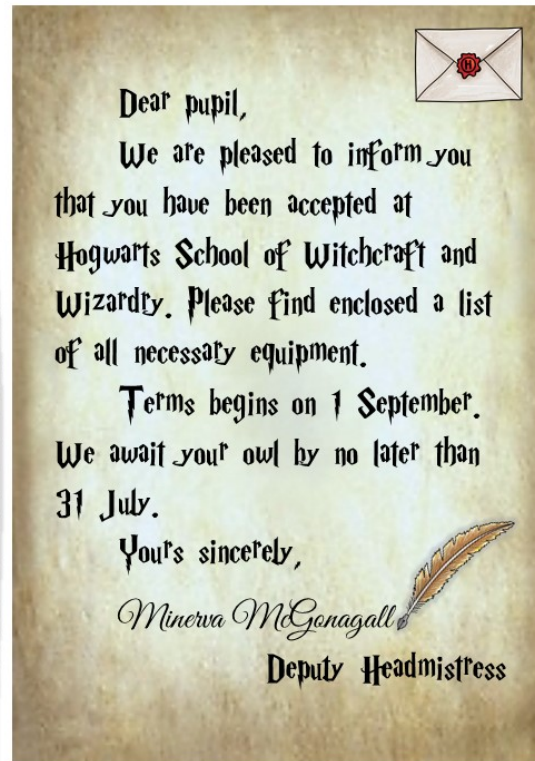
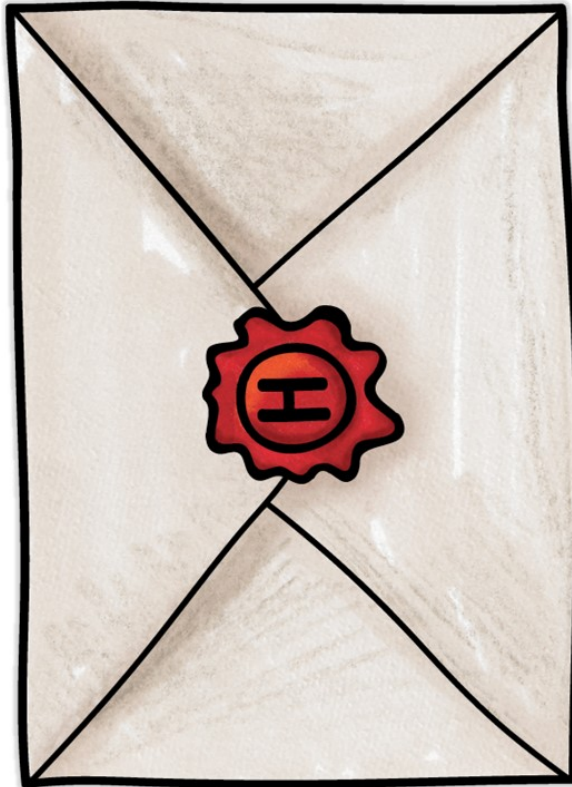

As a first task, ask your students to answer this invitation.



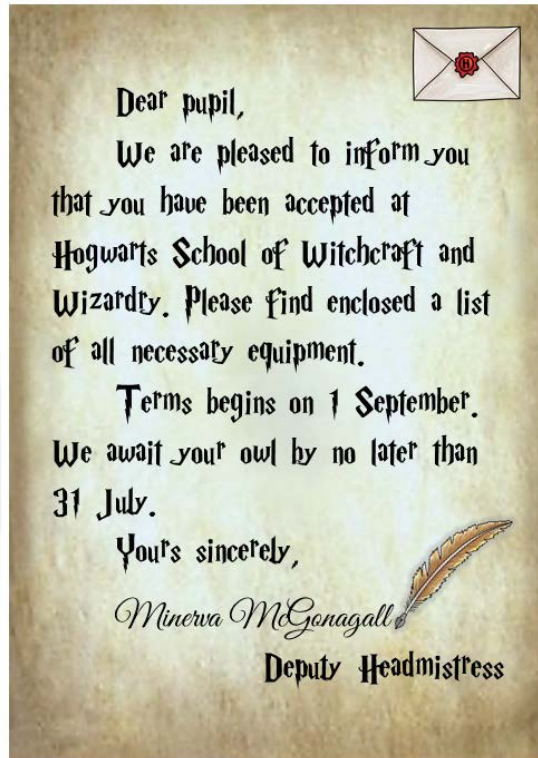

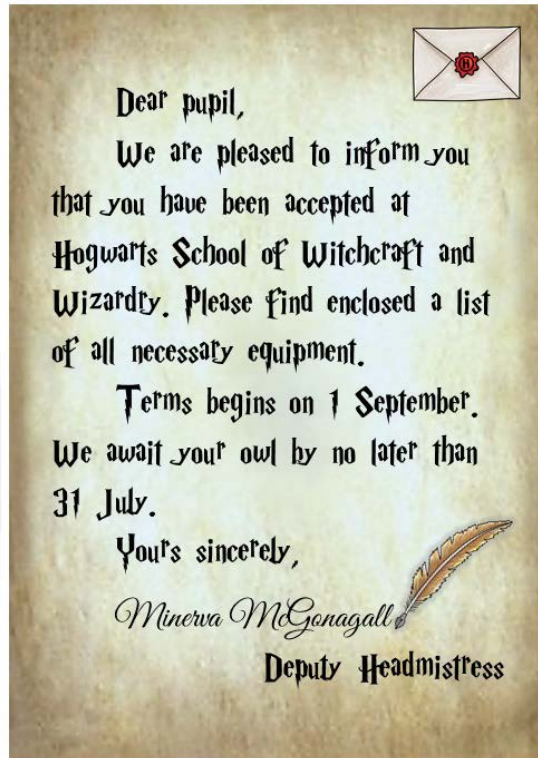

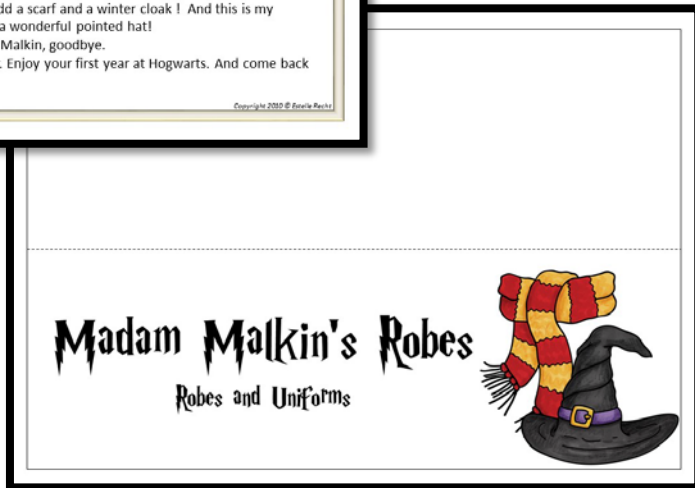
Shopping for a uniform

Harry : Well, it's nice to meet you too Madam... I'd like to buy a uniform, for ... Hogwarts.
Madam Malkin : Sure, come this way. I guess you need a complete outfit, don't you?
Harry : Well, yes. Hagrid said : a white shirt, a tie, a grey jumper, grey trousers, black shoes, grey socks, and of course a hat!
Madam Malkin : How many uniforms do you need to buy?
Harry : I need three uniforms please Madam.
Madam Malkin : Here you are : a white buttoned shirt, a striped tie, a jumper and trousers, grey socks and black shoes. And let me see ... this robe should suit you perfectly. Try them on.
Madam Malkin : You look great! Splendid.
Harry : How much is it?

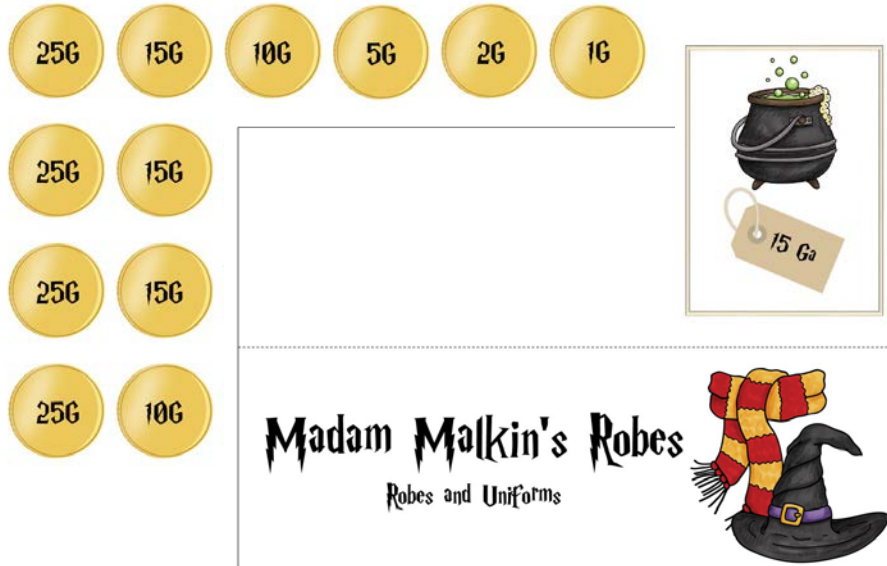

Hogwarts School Rules



- All students must be in uniform during classes. Uniform violations are subject to whatever punishment the Professor sees fit.
- No magic will be allowed in the corridors or in the library.
- Students must be in their common rooms by 9 P.M. every night, and must remain there until sunrise.
- The Forbidden Forest is strictly off limits to all students.
- Students are not allowed in the Restricted Section of the library without a written and signed permission slip from a Professor.
- First year students are not allowed to possess their own brooms. School brooms are provided for flying lessons and Quidditch.
- Any fighting or bullying will be strictly punished with detention or expulsion, depending on the severity.
- Love potions are not allowed at Hogwarts at any time.

Itinerary to the dormitory

Percy Weasley : Gryffindor, first years !! This way please. I'm your prefect. Tonight, I'll guide you through the school. Ready? To go to your dormitory, from the Great Hall, you need to take the Grand Staircase. Once you're on the 3rd floor, turn left and push a magic panel. There's a secret door behind it. Do you still follow me? Continue walking up the stairs. When you're on the 5th floor, lift the tapestry on your right, and enter the room behind it. Come on! You're almost there. Go up till the 7th floor. There's a corridor in front of you. Go straight to the very end of the corridor. There's a portrait of a very fat woman. Give her the password: Caput Draconis. Behind that door is the Gryffindor common room; it's a cosy, round room full of comfortable armchairs. The spiral staircase on your left leads to the girls' dormitory, the one on your right to the boys'. Good night and see you tomorrow. Breakfast is served at half past seven in the Great Hall.

What a prefect does at Hogwarts

A report by Rita Skeeter



Prefects are allowed to take House points away from other students in their own house as a penalty for rule-breaking, and they can give detentions as a form of punishment. They patrol the corridors of the Hogwarts Express on the way to school and they also patrol hallways to ensure that other students are not breaking curfew.

Prefects have other responsibilities as student leaders. They show the first years the way to their dormitories on their first day of school at Hogwarts School of Witchcraft and Wizardry, and supervise the decorating of the castle for Christmas (and other events as well). They also watch the younger students when bad weather keeps them indoors over break times.

Prefects are given a badge; the colours are the colours of the prefect's House. They have to wear the badge on their school uniform. The badge should have the letter "P" on it. If the prefect is on his or her house Quidditch team, he or she would not be required to wear the prefect badge on their Quidditch robes.

Percy Weasley

(b. 22 August, 1976) is a pure-blood wizard, the third child of Arthur and Molly Weasley, the younger brother of Bill and Charlie and the older brother of Ron, Ginny, George and Fred Weasley. He attended Hogwarts from 1987 to 1994. He takes the rules very seriously, and often punishes Fred and George for their jokes.
