An 18-year-old White man is accused of opening fire Saturday at a supermarket in Buffalo, killing 10 people and injuring three others, said law enforcement officials, who are investigating the incident as a hate crime and a case of racially motivated violent extremism.

Eleven of the 13 people shot were Black.



On May 15, 2022, a mass shooting occurred at a church in Laguna Woods, California. The church was hosting a congregation for Sunday services. The shooter killed one person and wounded five others. [2][3] A suspect, a 68-year-old man of Las Vegas, was arrested at the scene. Authorities allege that the crime was committed out of political hatred of those with different views on the situation in Taiwan.



On July 2, 2025, a mass drive-by shooting outside a nightclub occurred in Chicago, Illinois.

The shooting occurred during an album release party for drill rapper Mello Buckzz (born Melanie Doyle), who is the suspected target of the shooting.

The shooting started when a black vehicle drove past the venue with at least one person shooting at a crowd of people who were leaving the venue.

Four people were killed and fourteen others were injured. It is reported that there might have been multiple shooters involved.



On July 28, 2025, a mass shooting occurred at 345 Park Avenue in Midtown Manhattan, New York City.

The incident began at 6:28 p.m. A 27-year old gunman, wearing body armor, fired an AR-15–style rifle inside the building killing four people, including a New York City police officer who was off-duty and working as security.

The mass shooting is the deadliest in New York City since 2000.

The perpetrator's motive is being investigated by police.



On November 10, 2024, one person was killed and 16 others were injured in a mass shooting at Tuskegee University.

The shooting occurred at the end of the University's 100th Homecoming weekend during a party at around 1:40 a.m. on November 10 when multiple gunmen inside of a Dodge Charger shot several rounds of ammunition at people before exiting and continuing to open fire.



On October 1, 2017, a mass shooting occurred when 64-year-old Stephen Paddock opened fire on the crowd attending a music festival on the Las Vegas Strip in Nevada.

From his 32nd-floor suites in the Mandalay Bay hotel, he fired more than 1,000 rounds, killing 60 people and injuring at least 413.

About an hour later, he was found dead in his room.

The motive for the shooting is officially undetermined.

On February 14, 2018, an expelled student entered Parkland, Florida's Douglas High School and opened fire, killing 17 people and wounding 17 others, in what became at the time the deadliest shooting at a high school in United States history.

Nicolas Cruz's attack lasted less than four minutes. He left the school, on foot by blending in with other students and was arrested without incident approximately one hour and twenty minutes later in a city nearby.

Cruz had legally purchased an AR-15-style semi-automatic rifle from a gun store, after having passed the required background check. Prior to the purchase he had similarly obtained several other firearms. At the time of the shooting, in Florida, it was legal for people as young as 18 to purchase guns. The minimum age requirement has since been raised to 21.

On November 2, 2022, Cruz was sentenced to life.

The gunman who killed 19 kids and two teachers at a Texas elementary school in Uvalde, Texas, was a local high school student.

Officials said he legally purchased two assault rifles and scores of ammo last week for his 18th birthday.

The gunman stormed into Robb Elementary on Tuesday with an assault rifle and tactical vest, barricaded himself in adjoining classrooms of children and opened fire.

Responding officers eventually entered the room and fatally shot him.

*The 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment*


*A well regulated militia being necessary for the security of a free state; the right of the people to keep and bear arms Shall not be infringed*

- Open carry prohibited, concealed carry with permit




Comes into effect in Alabama on Jan 1, 2023. Some additional rules by locality, type of gun or others may apply. As of July 2022




