Cora 'Lovie' AUSTIN



Cora Taylor was born on September 19, 1887 in Chattanooga, Tennessee. She was an American musician. She was a bandleader, composer and singer. She is often considered as one of the best female jazz blues piano players of the period. Her nickname was 'Lovie'. She had eight brothers and sisters. She studied Music at Roger Williams University in Nashville. She first married Philip Austin in 1920.



Three years later, in 1923, she moved to Chicago. She worked with many top jazz musicians of the 1920s, including Louis Armstrong. She also created her own band, the « Blues Serenaders ». The band included trumpet, banjo, trombone players and drummers. In the early 1930s she became musical director for the Monogram Theater in Chicago. She worked there for twenty years. After World War II she became a pianist at Jimmy Payne's Dancing School at Penthouse Studios, and performed and recorded occasionally.

She died on July 8, 1972 in Chicago.
