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I - Today's lesson:

CLIQUE:

The pictures represent cliques: a girls' clique (A) and a boys' clique (B).

A- The girls **all*** wear pink **outfits***. They love shopping and boys.

B- The young men all wear / have **the same*** glasses. They **look clever*** / smart. Maybe they are geeks.

feather: plume

to flock: s'attrouper

together: ensemble

all: tous

outfit: tenue

the same: les mêmes

to look clever: avoir l'air intelligent

Pour marquer la possession au pluriel, on n'ajoute pas de "s" après l'apostrophe. Ex: A *girls'* clique = une clique *de* filles

Complete lesson:

A- This is a picture with four birds and a sentence: Birds of a Feather flock together.

B- The second picture was taken from a movie called "mean girls".

There are four young women who are wearing pink clothes / pink outfits.

We suppose they belong to the same clique. Three of them are wearing skirts but one of them isn't. That girl doesn't belong to the clique.

C- On the third picture, there are five young men.
