British Columbia, CANADA

There are 40,000,000 inhabitants, 10 provinces and 3 territories in Canada. It was founded* in 1867.*

The capital city is Ottawa. The biggest city is Toronto.

There are 2 official languages in Canada: English and French. Other languages, like Mandarin and Hindi are commonly spoken* in the Metro Vancouver region.*

Canada is also known for its maple syrup*, lovely colours on the tree leaves* in autumn and the beautiful cherry trees* in spring*.*
