	What is it?	What does it represent?
a	It is a portion of fish and chips.	Fish and chips is a typical dish in Britain. The British love it!
b	It's a cup of tea.	British people love drinking tea with biscuits at teatime (5 PM).
c	This is an umbrella and a bowler hat.	It represents a gentleman under the rain, because it's very rainy in the UK.
d	They are balls: a football and a rugby ball.	Both sports were invented by the English and are popular sports.
e	This is a 10-pound note.	The pound is the currency (= money used in the UK). The coins (= pieces) are the pence.
f	This is a typical British breakfast.	There is bacon and eggs, tomatoes, mushrooms, baked beans and sausages.
g	This is a line. People are queuing.	In the UK, people are very respectful of the rules. They respect the lines and queue in order of arrival.
h	This is an electric guitar.	It represents rock music. Many British bands are famous around the world: The Rolling Stones, The Beatles...
i	They are excuses.	Because British people are very polite in general.
