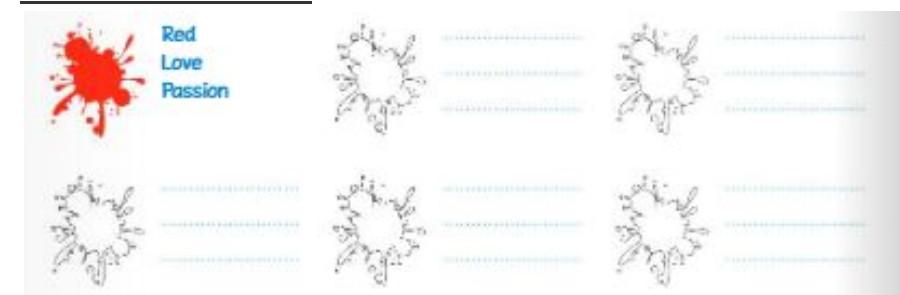

Purple is the color of magic and mystery.
